Stay at the Mansion House

Location: Oneida Community Mansion House

Description: The Oneida Community Mansion House was home to the utopian Oneida Community from 1848–1880. Today, you can explore museum galleries and period-furnished rooms, and stay overnight in the Mansion House's Inn. Set within 33 acres of lawns, gardens, and easy trails—with views toward the historic golf course—this location invites both learning and lingering.



Eat at Ye Olde Landmark Tavern

Location: Ye Olde Landmark Tavern, Bouckville

Description: Ye Olde Landmark Tavern is an 1850s Inn offering a full dining room on the main floor and period-style guest rooms upstairs. Visitors can expect fine dining in a comfortable environment, and an extensive wine list.



Visit Historic Peterboro

Location: National Abolition Hall of Fame and Museum

Visit the NAHOF museum and the Gerrit Smith Estate National Historic Landmark to learn about Peterboro's role in the abolitionist movement. These sites offer a meaningful look at the people and principles rooted in this historic community.
