MADISON-BOUCKVILLE ANTIQUE WEEK RETURNS AUGUST 9-15

*New York State's Largest Antiques Show Brings Over 2,000 Dealers to
Central New York for a Week of Treasure Hunting*

MADISON COUNTY, N.Y. — Antique lovers and treasure hunters are invited to Central New York as **Madison-Bouckville Antique Week** takes over the historic two-mile stretch of Route 20 through the towns of Madison and Bouckville.

Now recognized as New York State's largest outdoor antiques event, the show draws more than 2,000 dealers and vendors spread across several show fields, along with year-round antique shops and co-ops that stay open daily throughout the week. This August show marks the second of three signature Madison-Bouckville events on the 2026 calendar, following June's preview show and preceding the Holiday Stroll this November — together offering treasure hunters a reason to visit Central New York throughout the year.

For one week, the rolling countryside of Madison County transforms into a sprawling marketplace of antiques, collectibles, and one-of-a-kind curiosities. Shoppers can browse everything from vintage furniture and estate jewelry to advertising memorabilia, quilts, and Pyrex, with dealers traveling in from across the country to set up shop along the route. Eclectic food trucks and vendors line the fields throughout the week, and parking fees vary by show field.

“Madison-Bouckville Antique Week is one of the most anticipated weeks of the summer in Madison County,” said Kaytlynn Lynch, Executive Director of Visit Madison County. “It means so much to see how far this show has grown — antiquing has become such a huge market here in Central New York, across the country, and abroad, and for seven days, the spotlight will be on our stretch of Route

20, which will become a wonderful showcase of Madison County as a collector's destination.”

Admission to Madison-Bouckville Antique Week is free. Visitors are encouraged to shop early for the best selection, bring cash for smaller vendors and parking, and wear comfortable shoes for a day of walking the show fields. Local shops, restaurants, and lodging throughout Madison County will be open to welcome visitors throughout the week.
